Ama's Journey

Ama's Profile:



Young mother in an interfaith marriage (sole applicant, claim does not include husband and children).



Arrived in Australia after significant economic hardship.



Initial protection visa refused due to a false claim submitted based on incorrect advice and unknowing participation.



Seeking urgent legal advice for hearing scheduled within two weeks.

Legal Support and Key Actions:



Provided **urgent** legal advice.



Provide trauma-informed support.



Requested a 4-week adjournment allowing time to:



Deliver accurate legal advice regarding Australia's protection visa process, including consequences of false or misleading claims.



Followed up and advocated for **Administrative Review Tribunal (ART) decision** which was >6 months delayed.



Conduct a thorough **merits assessment**.



Submitted a **factual**, **corrected** protection claim.



It really helped me to have [a lawyer] there and she made notes and helped me to understand what was going on and what to say.



Provided **full representation** for appeal.

Outcomes for Ama:



Secured a **4-week adjournment** on the hearing.



Increased understanding of complex legal system, allowing a new, genuine case to be presented to the ART.



Successfully added children to the remitted application, supporting family unity.



The ART remittal created a pathway for Ama's **husband to remain in** Australia with his family.

Outcomes for System:



Greater fairness and efficiency in **decision making**, noting that research and evidence provided by our legal team was referred to throughout the ART's decision record.



Greater integrity in protection outcomes. Our legal service played a critical role in ensuring accurate and correct information was provided to the ART, including addressing previously provided false claims.
